ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Project entries must represent either new power plants OR innovative projects at existing facilities anywhere in the world.
- Eligible projects include, but are not limited to:
 - New power plants
 - Retrofit projects, including those featuring installation of controls and environmental equipment
 - Re-powering projects
 - Innovative use of technology
 - Equipment upgrades, including turbines, boilers and auxiliary equipment
 - Innovative diagnostic analysis and maintenance programs
 - Unique construction management and plant design programs
 - Combustion optimization
- Nominated projects must have gone into service between August 1, 2008, and July 31, 2009.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Any interested party may submit a project for award consideration.
- Include a description of the project detailing the reasons it should be named *Power Engineering* Project of the Year 2009.
- Description should clearly indicate the facts and features making the project innovative and/or unique.
- Description should not exceed 1,000 words and should include:
 - Quantified economic viability/benefits to customers, shareholders and owners. (Quantified information will be used for judging, will remain confidential and will not be published without project participants' permission.)
 - Innovation – technology, engineering, construction practices, etc.
 - Environmental benefits/improvements – quantify to greatest extent.
 - Benefits to local community and economy.
 - Unique challenges and obstacles encountered and overcome during project.

Supporting material, such as photographs and newspaper/media clippings, is not required, but may be included.
