Spectra is a lightweight, ergonomic, handheld digital imaging instrument that aids the dentist in detecting caries visually. Spectra operates using fluorescence technology. LEDs project high-energy light with a wavelength of 405 nanometers onto the tooth surface, causing cariogenic bacteria to fluoresce red. In contrast, healthy enamel fluoresces green. The captured data is sent to the computer and the live image is presented on the monitor. Images can be saved to the patient record for future reference.
